




Risky requirements – example from Russia (FSC)

When can risk based approaches be applied?

- Clear criteria for evaluating the risk
- Clear thresholds for low risk/specified risk.
- Competence of people doing risk assessment
- Data available
- Specify the risk to as detailed level as possible

Note

 Risk assessments conducted by certificate holders have turned out to be low quality.

2. Is HCVF sufficiently protected?




HCVF Category 3 (Woodland Key Habitats) in private forest are not protected by the legislation.





Destruction of Woodland Key Habitats






Fig. 2. Impact of commercial activities on WKH in private forests.


