## 1 Introduction

The BioGrace managers store personal contact data with the purpose to send news messages. Personal data of our users is only collected, stored and used insofar as this is necessary for sending out news messages. The collection and use of personal data takes place only with the consent of the user.

## 2 Data protection policy

### 2.1 Description and consent of data processing

Users can subscribe to free news messages (short newsletters) from the website [www.BioGrace.net](http://www.BioGrace.net).

When registering for news messages, the users' name and e-mail address that are entered on the website are transmitted to us. In this document, "personal data" therefore refers to names and e-mail addresses.

Through entering name and e-mail address on the website, the user gives consent for the processing of personal data following this data protection policy.

### 2.2 Purpose of data processing

The users' email address is collected for delivering the news messages. The users' name is collected to personalize the news message.

### 2.3 No transfer of data

Personal data obtained via subscription to news messages is only collected and stored for sending out electronic news messages. It is not used for other purposes. No personal data will be transferred to third parties.

### 2.4 Duration of storage

Personal data of the user will be stored as long as the user is subscribed to the news messages.

### 2.5 Removal of personal data

Personal data will be deleted as soon as they are no longer necessary to achieve the purpose for which it is collected. The user can end the subscription to the news messages at any time via a corresponding link in every news message and via an "unsubscribe" field on the website. Ending the subscription will result in repealing the consent to store personal data. The BioGrace managers will delete the personal data for users that ended their subscription to the news messages.
